“I thought the ‘Learning Pathway’ was a good help and that the ‘You need to know’ and ‘You need to do’ were especially helpful for time management.”

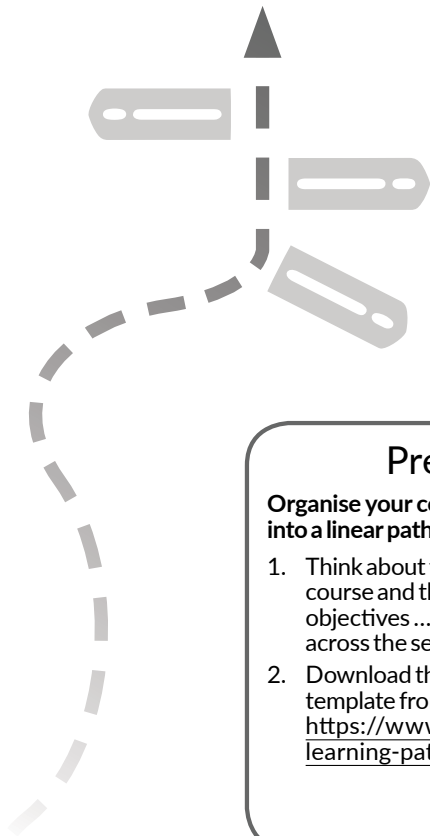

SET UP YOUR PATHWAY

Prepare

Organise your content and activities into a linear pathway

1. Think about the narrative of your course and the learning objectives ... how does it play out across the semester?
2. Download the Learning Pathway template from our website: <https://www.elipse.uq.edu.au/learning-pathway-stage-1>

STEP 1 -Choose

Choose a template

- A. Weeks**
weekly structure
- B. Topics**
topical structure
- C. Projects**
weekly structure + content selector (e.g. different projects)

Save the selected template zip file to your computer

STEP 2 - Import

On **Control Panel**, expand the Packages and Utilities section. Select **Import Package/View Logs**

1. Click **Import Package**.
2. Browse for the zip file you saved earlier and **select the template** you wish to use.
3. Select **Content Areas**
4. Click **Submit**.

STEP 3 - Link

Link content and activities:

1. Click **Build Content** to access the drop-down list.
2. Select **Course/Organisation/School Link** (names depend on your LMS environment).
3. Browse for the course item you wish to link, **select + submit**
4. **Mark the current week in the pathway by prepending "**" to the folder name**
